
### **Overview Quick Results pane**

- 4. Submit to Duke HERO Program.



- 1. Open the existing Ekotrope application for this project.
- 2. Make the changes to the Ekotrope app.
- 3. Open the Project Info tab > ICF > change the status to Final Submission > Save.
- 4. Submit Project to Duke RNC Program.
- 5. Email Chase and <u>DERNC@icf.com</u> to let us know you completed the required changes.
